## GamersArray Channel Permission

The GamersArray Channel Management System includes a permission system for founders to configure permissions for other people on GamersArray.

### Types

**Founder** - This permission allows all. Founders can add/remove Founders, Operators, Half-Op and Voice. Founders can also delete channels. Founders can not remove the channel creators permissions, but can delete the channel - Giving this permission is your responsibility.

**Operator** - This group allows editing of channels and permissions. Operator can only add/remove View permission from GamersArray, and can only modify clients that are Voice or Half-Op in TeamSpeak. Operators can create and modify channels but can not delete channels.

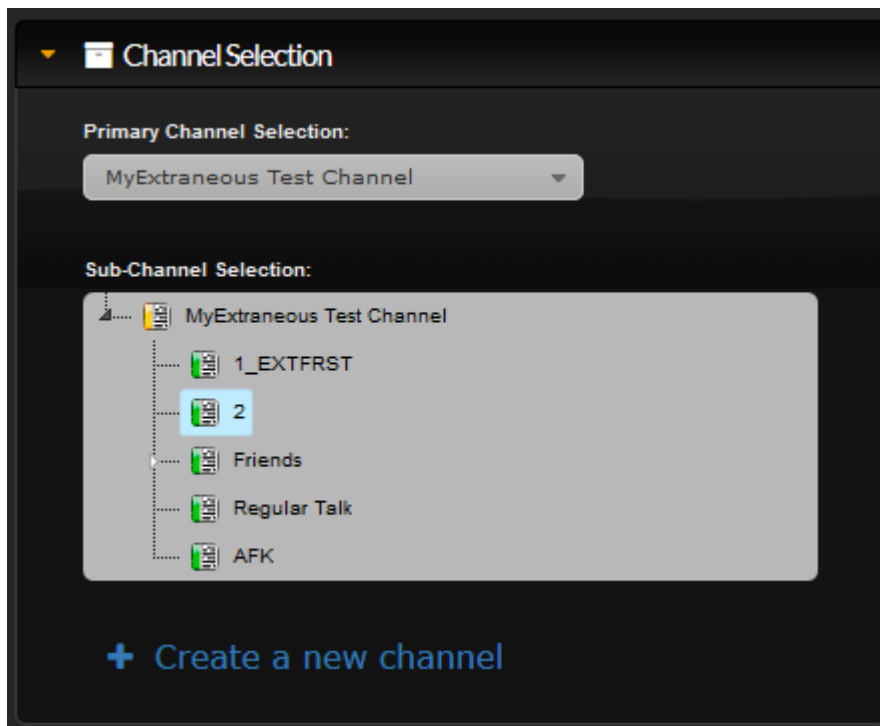
**View** - This only allows people to view. This group is unable to modify, add, or remove anything.

\* Permissions Inheritance is enabled. If someone has permission for one channel they will have permissions for all sub-channels part of that channel.

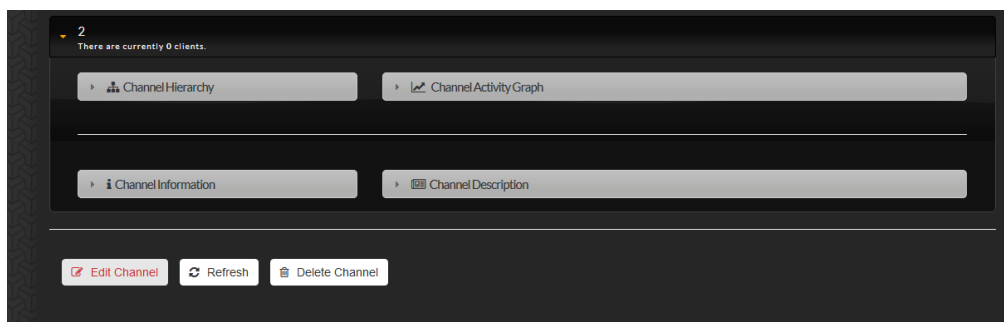
\* In order for people to take advantage of this system, they will need a GamersArray account.

### Add/Change/Remove Permissions

1. Select the channel which you wish to give someone permission.



2. Click Edit Channel



3. Click Permissions > GamersArray

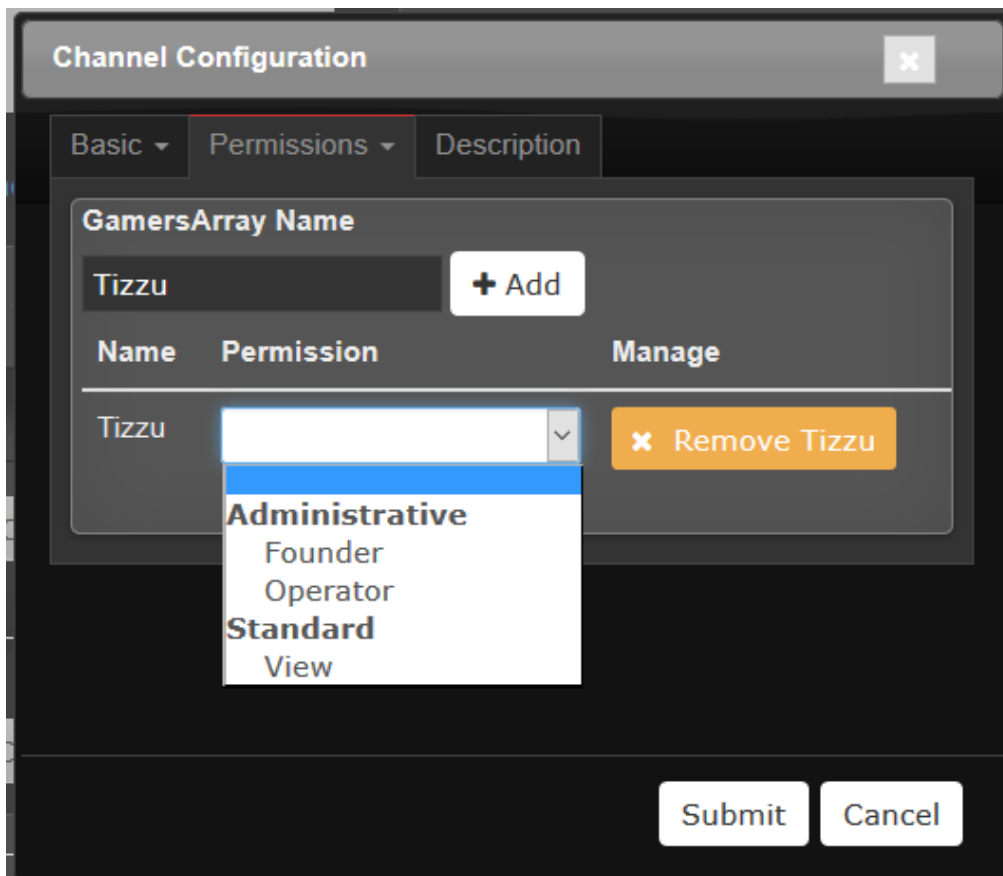

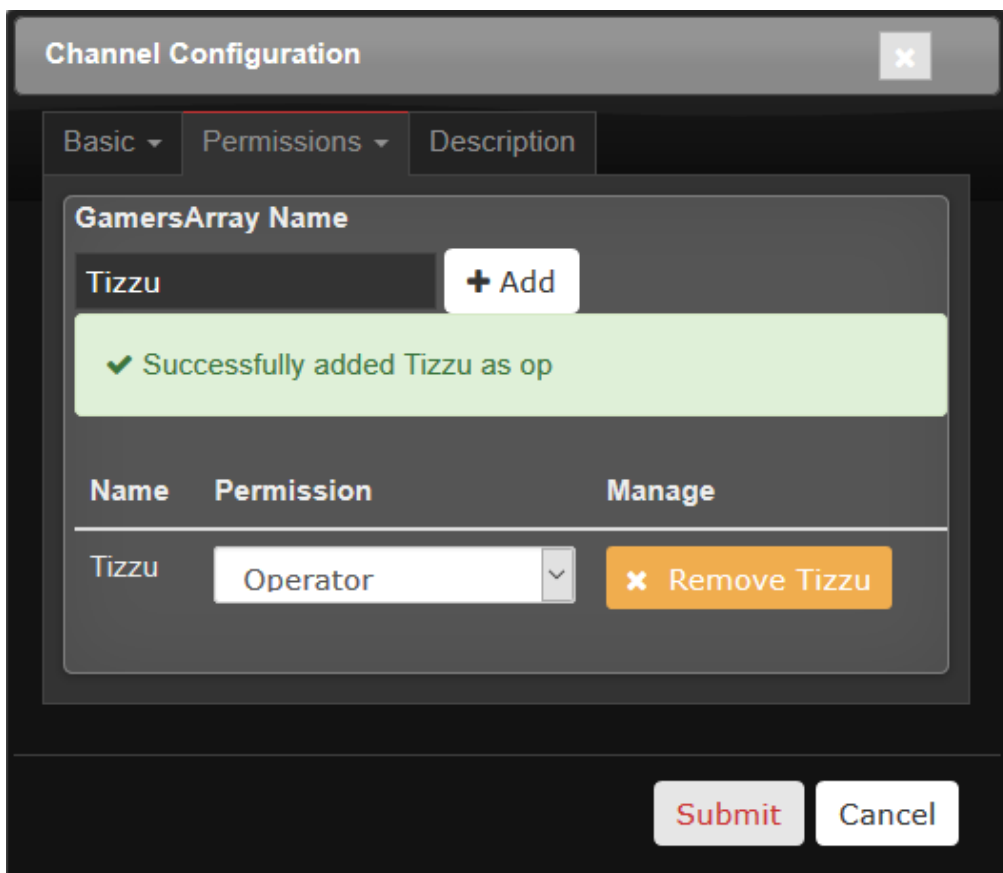
